NOTICE OF ENDING A DOMESTIC PARTNERSHIP

**** Read this before you sign ****

When to use this Notice?

When a domestic partnership ends, at least one partner must sign a Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership, stating that the partnership has ended. The notice must be dated and signed under penalty of perjury.

Where do I submit my Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership form?

You must submit a Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership to the Office of the City Clerk located at: **One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, 2nd Floor, Room 201, Oakland, CA 94612.**

When does a Domestic Partnership End?

A Domestic Partnership ends when:

- The Partners stop living together for more than 90 days
- One of the partners sends the other a Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership
- One of the partners gets married
- One of the partners dies

Who gets a copy of this Notice?

You must send a copy of the Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership to your former partner, unless he or she has died. You should send it to the address shown on your Affidavit of Domestic Partnership. Also, you should send it to any other address you have for your former partner.

If you or your partner gave a copy of your Certificate of Domestic Partnership to anyone else, such as an employer or other entity, you must send that employer or other entity a copy of the Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership. If your former partner has died, you must send a copy of this Notice of Ending a Domestic Partnership to whom your partner gave a copy of the Certificate of Domestic Partnership.
