

CORE Group Leader Roster

The CORE Program regularly receives requests from community members who want to connect with other CORE-trained individuals in their area. The purpose of the Group Leader Roster is to allow people who live in a given area to make contact with a local neighborhood leader and potentially join their CORE Group. Our hope is that this system will improve the ability of those with CORE training to network with each other, strengthen CORE Groups, and enhance the CORE experience for all.
