(CPR)

CARDIO PULMONARY RESUSCITATION

CPR saves life. Learn how to perform CPR until the fire department paramedics arrive. Oakland Fire Department, in conjunction with the American Safety & Health Institute offers the following courses:

CPR & AED for Community and Workplace: This course is for people who would like to know CPR for their family and friends.

CPR Pro: This course is for people who need to maintain CPR certification for their jobs in healthcare.



BASIC FIRST AID

You will learn how to stop bleeding, stabilize broken bones, and treat for shock. This course is designed for people who want to help when professional rescuers have not yet arrived. This First Aid course can be combined with CPR & AED for Community and Workplace.



(EMT)

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN

The professional qualification to begin working on an ambulance, EMT is the first step to becoming a paramedic. This challenging course is offered as a part of the partnership of the City of Oakland and Peralta Community Colleges. PARAMEDIC CADET PROGRAM

A community based program designed to prepare people to enter public services as firefighter paramedics. Paramedic cadets receive field experience and classroom training in fire science and emergency medical services.

VIAL OF LIFE PROGRAM

This program is designed to provide pertinent medical information to first responders and emergency room physicians regarding patients who have existing medical or chronic illnesses. The vial contains much of the medical history and emergency contact information for family members and physician.
