As a separate and independent basis, this proposal is also exempt under each of the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) CEQA Guidelines: Section 15183-Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning; Section 15331-Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation; and, Section 15061(b) (3)-Review for Exemption.


