In June 2008, the City Council directed staff to develop regulations for Primary Recycling Collection Centers in the City's industrial areas in consultation with residents, the recycling industry and other affected stakeholders. These regulations would be brought to the Planning Commission and City Council as revisions to the Oakland Planning Code for adoption. As of the date of the Zoning Update Committee's (ZUC) September 17, 2008 meeting, staff will have held two meetings with stakeholders (on 8/7/08 and 9/4/08).

Staff would like the ZUC to consider and discuss a proposal and potential alternatives for regulations regarding Primary Recycling Collection Centers in the CIX (Commercial and Industrial Mix) and IG (General Industrial) industrial zoning districts.
