Below you will find general information which will help to ensure that your concert experience is enjoyable. If you have any questions or concerns during the concert, please look for the volunteers. Otherwise, sit back, relax and have a wonderful time listening to the music.

ADMISSION AND TIME – FREE! FREE! FREE!

Admissions to all of Councilperson Desley Brooks' Music in Arroyo Park concert performances are free; no tickets or advance reservations are required. Arroyo Viejo is a public park and is open all day, from sunrise to sunset. **Concert schedule and Artist line-up are as follows:**

TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING

Parking in the area is very limited. Concert-goers are encouraged to park at Eastmont Town Center lower level near the Senior Housing facility (old professional building) and shuttle to the park.

Shuttle Service will leave from the Senior Housing facility (old Professional Building) at Eastmont Town Center (on the Church Street side) and travel to the park every 20 minutes. Return Shuttles from Arroyo Park will leave from 77th and Krause.

Public Transportation:

BART: to Coliseum/Oakland airport to AC Transit Bus #50/Bay Fair BART; get off: 73rd Av & Bancroft Av

By Car:

- From the North Bay: 80-East to 580-East. Exit Edwards Ave. Turn right onto Edwards. Edwards becomes Sunkist Dr. Turn slight Left onto 73rd Ave. Turn left onto Krause Ave.

- From the South Bay: 880-North to exit Hegenberger Rd/Coliseum. Turn left onto Edes Ave. Turn right onto Hegenberger Rd. Turn slight right onto 73rd Ave. Turn right onto Krause Ave.
- From the East Bay: 580-west to exit Golf Links Rd toward 98th Ave. Turn left onto Golf Links Rd. Left onto 82nd Ave. Turn right onto Bancroft Ave. Turn left onto 77th Ave. Turn Left onto Krause Ave.

Please **respect our neighbors** and do not block driveways and crosswalks! Your car will be ticketed or towed.

SEATING

General Seating: lawn seating is available to all. We suggest you **arrive early for best seating**. You may bring blankets and low chairs (you may be asked to limit the size or your ground cover due to space restrictions). **To assure good visibility for all patrons, tall chairs or umbrellas are only permitted toward the back of the concert area.**

REFRESHMENTS

Arroyo Viejo Advisory Members will be selling soft drinks, juices and water.

Picnics are welcome. Trash and recycling containers are located throughout the park. **Be a good neighbor and dispose of your trash!**

Barbecues are not allowed on concert Sundays due to fire regulations.

RULES ABOUT ALCOHOL

No Alcohol is permitted in the park.

SMOKING

A City-wide ordinance prohibits smoking in all public parks. **Smoking is not allowed in any area in Arroyo Viejo Park.**

PETS

Pets are not permitted in the concert area (except service animals). Pets are allowed in other areas of the park as long as they are on a leash.

PLEASE NOTE

- The concert area will be closed to further admissions if capacity is reached.
- Walkways must be kept clear at all times.
- Recording/photography of performers is strictly prohibited.
- Unauthorized sales, solicitation, and distribution are prohibited.
- You may be asked to limit the size of your blanket or tarp. Unoccupied blankets will be subject to removal and can be collected at lost and found.
- Backstage areas are restricted to authorized personnel.
- Management reserves the right to revoke admission.
- Dress comfortably and remember to be prepared for sun or fog!
- Please be aware of personal items. The Festival cannot assume responsibility for lost or stolen items.
