**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE AND
APPROPRIATION OF FEDERAL CONGESTION MITIGATION AIR
QUALITY/PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
PROGRAM (P-TAP) FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000 FOR
STREET RESURFACING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA 21) (Public Law 105-178, June 9, 1998) and the TEA 21 Restoration Act (Public Law 105-206, July 22, 1998) continue the Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) Program; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's Pavement Technical Assistance Program (P-TAP) provides CMAQ funding for consulting services to assist local jurisdictions with implementation/evaluation of their pavement management systems; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to TEA 21, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, eligible project sponsors wishing to receive CMAQ P-TAP grants for a project shall submit an application first with the appropriate metropolitan transportation planning organization (MPO), for review and inclusion in the MPO's Pavement Technical Assistance Program (P-TAP); and

WHEREAS, the MTC is the MPO for the San Francisco Bay region; and

WHEREAS, the MTC retains consulting firms to service the P-TAP; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is an eligible project sponsor for CMAQ P-TAP funds; and

WHEREAS, these funds are intended for P-TAP consultant services to assist project sponsors in implementing/evaluating their pavement management systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland wishes to submit a grant application for \$35,000 to MTC for funds from the Surface Transportation Program P-TAP in fiscal year 2000-2001 for P-TAP consulting services to assist with the evaluation/upgrading of the City of Oakland's pavement management system; and

WHEREAS, MTC requires, as part of the application, a resolution stating the following:

- 1) the commitment of necessary local matching funds of at least 11.5%; and
- 2) that the sponsor understands that the CMAQ funding is fixed at the programmed amount, and therefore any cost increase cannot be expected to be funded with CMAQ funds; and
- 3) the sponsor to complete the project within 120 days from the start of the project; and

WHEREAS, the required local matching funds of at least 11.5 percent (\$4,050) are available from the FY2000-01 general fund appropriations; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Oakland by its adoption of this resolution does hereby authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute and file an application, accept and appropriate funding provided by the MTC P-TAP provision in the amount of (\$35,000) for technical assistance in the evaluation/upgrading of the City of Oakland’s pavement management system; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council of the City of Oakland by adopting this resolution does hereby state that:

- 1) The City of Oakland will provide \$4,050 (11.5%) in local matching funds from existing fiscal year 2000-01 appropriations; and
- 2) The City of Oakland understands that the CMAQ P-TAP funding for the project is fixed (\$35,000), and that any cost increases must be funded by the City of Oakland from local matching funds, and that the City of Oakland does not expect any cost increases to be funded with CMAQ funds; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution will be transmitted to the MTC in conjunction with the filing of the application; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the MTC is requested to support the application for the project described in the resolution and to program the project, if approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That this resolution has been approved by the Office of the City Attorney as to form and legality, and a copy is on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
