INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER _____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DONATION OF TWO SURPLUS POLICE PATROL VEHICLES TO THE CITY OF DALIAN, CHINA

WHEREAS, the City Manager has determined that two (2) police patrol cars, vehicle numbers 1707 and 1723, which are 1997 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor vehicles, are surplus property owned by the City, which have a value exceeding their continued care, handling maintenance or storage; and

WHEREAS, said police patrol vehicles are surplus to the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the donation of two (2) of the City's surplus police patrol vehicles to the City of Dalian, China, will assist Dalian in the development of a police and safety program modeled on Oakland's; and

WHEREAS, the donation these vehicles would strengthen cultural ties with Dalian, encourage cultural and educational exchange, and further support the Dalian-Oakland Sister City programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may, pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code, Article 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.120, C, authorize the donation of surplus property, the value of which exceeds the cost of continued care, handling, maintenance or storage, to public agencies; and

WHEREAS, in addition to certain other releases, the City of Dalian, China, has agreed to indemnify and hold harmless the City, its Councilmembers, officers and agents from liability for actions, claims, losses, etc. that arise from the use of the police patrol vehicles; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That, pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code, Article 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.120, C, the City Council finds and determines that vehicle numbers 1707 and 1723, 1997 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors owned by Oakland, are surplus to the needs of the City; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby finds and determines that, in the interests supporting sister city programs, it is in the best interests of the City to donate surplus police patrol vehicles to the City of Dalian, China, and authorizes the City Manager to take this action.
