RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING APRIL 27, 2001 TO BE OAKLAND'S ARBOR DAY 2001 AND AUTHORIZING AN OFFICIAL TREE PLANTING CEREMONY AT THE LAKE MERRITT WILDLIFE REFUGE AND ROTARY NATURE CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has long been recognized for its innovative street tree planting and maintenance programs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has met the standards set by the National Arbor Day Foundation to be deemed a "Tree City, U.S.A" for the eighteenth year; and

WHEREAS, April 27, 2001, has been designated as the official Arbor Day for the USA; and

WHEREAS, tree planting projects are planned for Arbor Day on April 27, 2001 in the City of Oakland; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That Friday, April 27, 2001, shall be proclaimed Arbor Day in the City of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all official tree planting ceremonies be held on Friday, April 27, 2001 at the Lake Merritt Wildlife Refuge and Rotary Nature Center.
