Weather:	Overcast, approximately 62 degrees Fahrenheit, and winds approximately 0 to 5 mph.	

ACTIVITY: Whipsnake Fence Inspection

Inspected the entire continuous line of fence in the lower quarry as well as the two separate fences in the upper quarry at Campus Drive. Overall, the fencing complied with the requirements of the project's Special Status Species Mitigation and Monitoring Plan. Areas of fencing requiring minor adjustments and maintenance level repairs were marked with white flagging to assist repair crews and discussed with a DeSilva Gates representative.

ACTIVITY: Clearing

Noted that previously cleared vegetation within the Ridgmont Basin area has begun to grow back. Spoke with a DeSilva Gates representative and recommended that the area should be cleared again due to the potential for the vegetation to attract breeding birds. Also recommended the continued close coordination with WRA to insure that necessary surveys occur prior to these activities.
